Homework

Even in 1st grade, homework is important to a child's learning. It is a chance for them to practice independently what we have been learning in the classroom. This, however, does not mean they should do it all alone. Your help and guidance is IMPORTANT!! Together find a comfortable place to work. Please sit with your child and answer questions they may have. When they are finished, please check their work. Your involvement shows them that you care about their learning and that you and I are a team working together to help them learn.

What Kind of Homework??

Homework days are: Monday -Thursday

Math: Each night your child will bring home a math worksheet. The goal of this homework is to increase their fluency in math facts. We encourage you to time them for 1 min and 30 seconds, however, this is not required. We are working on memorizing math facts so that as we grow older we can concentrate on harder math concepts and not get stuck on the computation part.

RAH: Read at Home!! At Sunset we have the expectation that student will read **OR** be read to for 20 minutes. Inside their family folder will be a monthly calendar. After your child reads, please initial the correct date.

**This is only assigned Monday-Thursday, however, we would love for you to encourage your child to read every night, including the weekends.

Spelling: Each week your child will receive a new list of spelling words that correlates with the sounds we are working on. Please be on the lookout for a letter every Monday that tells their new words. **SPELLING TESTS WILL BE ON FRIDAY!!**

Sight Words: Be on the lookout for flashcards coming home. These are the words your child is practicing for the week. Please help them learn to read the words! Our goal is for your child to read 300 or more sight words by the end of 1st grade.
